On Thursday October 18, first part of the afternoon, we propose you **two short excursions, in alternative** and you are kindly required to choose one of them. You can either visit **Grotta Gigante** (namely Giant Cave), a large typical cave of the Karst surrounding Trieste. This trip would be the best complement of the introductory lecture to Karst phenomena that will be given on Tuesday afternoon. The visit to the cave includes a descent of about 120 m to the cave bottom, following a touristic path with steps. If you prefer a more relaxing trip, you can visit Miramare Castle and Park. The castle has been built between 1856 and 1860 on a beautiful promontory in the Grignano bay to become the residence of Archduke Maximilian of Austria, the Emperor of Mexico.
